Things we would like to discuss in more detail over the phone:

- · Uncontrolled pain or a sudden increase in pain.
- Not having your bowels open for more than three days or are loose.
- · Feeling more shortness of breath than normal.
- · Change in sputum and frequency.
- · Wound concerns oozing, red, swollen.
- · Emotional support.
- · Swelling or redness in your calf.
- Any side effects of the medication.

· Anything / any changes you are concerned about.

If you feel sudden onset of shortness of breath, with or without pain, you should call 999. Please take this card along with your discharge summary anytime you seek medical help.
